





3. Fruitfulness


1. Discipleship is about Restoration


2. Discipleship is about Nations



Matt 28:- “Go into all the world and make disciples.”


Discipleship is NOT just about individuals

3. Discipleship is about Bearing Fruit




John 15: 7-8 - If you remain in me... my father's glory is that you bear much fruit... that will show you are my disciples...
